To publish your professional profile, it is necessary to upload a sample of your voice in 3 different types of voices. You can upload samples from your past successful projects or you can record these suggested texts.

Type of voice: "COMMERCIAL"

energetic, believable speech advertising a service or a product – the goal is to get people's attention and make them interested in it

Type of voice: "EXPLAINER"

calm, easy to understand and explanatory speech, fitting for descriptions, lessons, tutorials etc.
